

Dear Micha,

I am in Eilat working on a series of videos that feature a Bible teacher from the USA. The 12 previous DVD that we have produced featuring this teacher have been seen by audiences worldwide and we are excited about this next series in which we will film some Israel locations as well as several locations in Jordan, Greece, and Rome.

We have a few needs for which we knew we would need a local fixer so we sought out a local fixer who was recommended by another producer. Our needs, for which we sought assistance, include:

- Permission to film at Khirbet Midras early afternoon on Wednesday, 30 October.
- Permission to film at the southern steps of the Temple ruins at Ophel Park on Thursday, 31 October for about an hour, maybe two starting at roughly 9am.
- A first century looking fishing boat to film on the shore of the Sea of Galilee at Capernaum early Friday morning, 1 November.
- Permission to film at the Ancient Park of Qatzrin on Sunday, 3 Nov for several hours, starting as early as they'll allow.

A couple of weeks ago, our fixer assured us that the permits for these locations were well underway and that we should plan to see photos of a boat forthwith. Last week, when I sought an update, I was told not to worry, was promised that we would have permission for these locations upon our arrival, and that the fixer would meet us at the airport today with the appropriate paperwork.

Today, upon our arrival at TLV, I tried several times by phone and email to reach our fixer. I finally

received an email from her assistant a few minutes ago – she wrote me that access to these sites ‘will be fine’ but that she thinks it’s best if we work with them directly from this point. And we finally received a photo of the boat, but it looks very modern, not first century at all.

I am extremely disappointed that they are not following through with their commitment to us, but more importantly, I need professional help to finish up these location permissions. If you are available to assist us immediately, I would like to discuss engaging you to do so.
